

## SAMPLE SCHEDULE 1

This is a sample schedule showing the possible positioning of science pre-requisite courses in a four-year plan for a student that is considering studying abroad and applying to medical school after their THIRD year of college. This schedule would prepare the student for the MCAT for a late spring test date in the third year.

We encourage students to incorporate coursework that will prepare them for the 'Psychological, Social, and Biological Foundations of Behavior' section of the MCAT. This could entail courses in Psychology, Sociology, Science in Society, and possibly Anthropology. Take a look at the Health Studies Cluster to gain an idea of a number of health related courses offered on campus. Additionally, students will need to complete a year of ENGL for most health professional programs. Medical Schools classify acceptable ENGL courses as those that encompass Composition and Rhetoric, Creative Writing and Literature.
