

# Calculating the Science GPA

List all of your science courses, include the grade obtained, the number of credits for the course, and the grade points attached to the grade you obtained, for example an A is generally considered a 4.0, a B is a 3.0, a C grade is a 2.0. Please note that the list below is just an example and is missing science courses such as math and physics.

25.9 divided by 5.75 = 4.5 i.e. the Science GPA is 4.5
